Multiple-Tooth Replacement



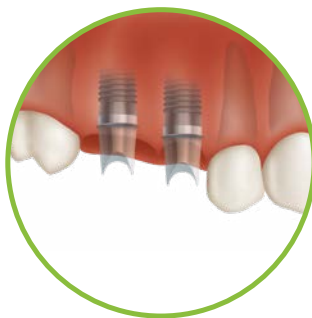
The multiple-tooth restoration is used when two or more adjacent teeth are missing.



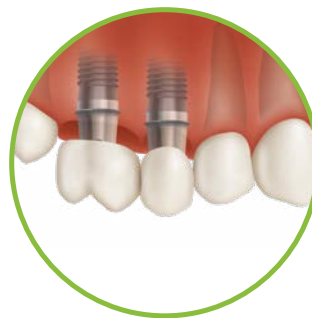
Implants are placed at the site of each missing tooth.



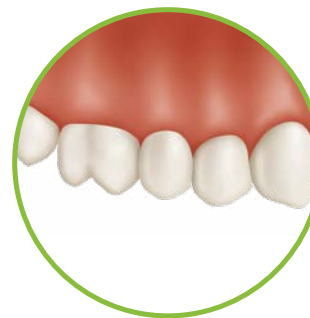
Implants will be left to heal for a few weeks to several months, depending on the quality of the bone.



Following healing, titanium posts are screwed into the implant bodies.



Restorations are then attached to the abutments with dental cement or screws.



The replacement tooth, or crown, is cemented or screwed onto the implant, creating an aesthetic and functional restoration.
